

Your boat, caravan or mobile home is filled with costly high quality finishes such as wood and fabrics. These materials are very susceptible to dampness caused by the air (humidity). Boats and caravans are often unused for several months of the year and remain sealed and unventilated for a long time. If a dehumidifier is not used, moist air becomes trapped inside, leading to that familiar damp, musty scent of mould and fungus bacteria. If untreated, your wooden finishes become stained, and soft fabrics start to develop mould and will eventually rot. Without a dehumidifier, it would be hard to keep an eye and constantly be there to keep things ventilated.

A dehumidifier will remove moisture from the air (humidity) of a sealed boat or caravan and feed into a reservoir tank or drained outside, effectively removing all moisture from the air, and keeping your boat or caravan damp free. Such finishes will quickly deteriorate and become tarnished even after short periods of time. Portable dehumidifier units can be used to dehumidify any interior, large or small. Also, as power cuts always happen on these vehicles, the dehumidifier has an auto restart even if the power cuts out.
